Brethren Woods Summer Staff

We are looking for strong, solid Christians to serve in June and July during our 6-week summer camp program as paid Summer Staff. Open positions include male and female counselors, lifeguards, and kitchen assistants. Be sure to check out our Summer Staff webpage at <http://www.brethrenwoods.org/summerstaff> to review job descriptions, get more information about serving at camp, and apply online!

In addition to our paid staff, Brethren Woods depends on about 60 Volunteer Staff members to run our summer camp program. Positions include deans (Bible study and worship leaders), health managers, camp counselors, support staff, kitchen and maintenance assistants, and activity leaders. Volunteers can serve for a day, half-week, or week-long session.

Our Jr. Staff Program is designed for youth who are interested in learning leadership skills to be used at camp and in other settings, such as school, church, and the community. Jr. Staff serve for two weeks during the summer - one in a family group as a junior counselor and one in a support staff role (crafts assistant, nature assistant, maintenance assistant, support staff, etc.) A required spring training weekend (May 1st-3rd) is held to teach leadership skills and introduce Jr. Staff to camp's operation. Applications need to be in by March 15th. Space is limited to 12 youth. Final decisions for these positions will be made by April 1st.
