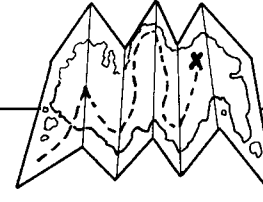
Paul said it is important for Christians to have a spirit of unity. Why?
